
Mission

- To foster a scientific temper and encourage students to adopt a rational approach to solving problems.






About College

The college was established in 1961, under the aegis of the Dhamangaon Education Society- the oldest Institution in Vidarbha region-catering to the needs of education from 1914. The Society, managed by dedicated local persons, has currently 14 institutions working under it consisting of 3 Balmandirs, 1 English Convent, Marathi & English Primary Schools, 2 High Schools, 2 Jr. colleges, a Polytechnic & Engineering College. A degree college with PG course and a Computer Institute, ADARSHA SCIENCE, JAIRAMDAS BHAGCHAND ARTS & BIRLA COMMERCE MAHAVIDYALAYA is one of them. In 1961, this college was started with Arts & Commerce faculties only. The science faculty was added to it in 1972. Presently this college is a multi-disciplinary one, with B.A., B.Com., (Eng. Medium/Marathi Medium) B.Sc., B.C.A., M.A. (Economics), M.Sc. (Electronics, Micro-Bio, Mathematics), M.Com. (Eng. Medium), M.C.M. & Ph.D. in Microbiology, Electronics & Botany as also Jr. college imparting Science, Arts & Commerce education. The College is a pioneer to start Microbiology & Computer education in the entire Vidarbha region from 1979 and 1987 respectively. Presently it has computer Science is one of the electives in the faculty of science as well as in the Commerce faculty & Information Technology (IT) as an elective subject in the Junior college level. A facility in Computer Centre is also available where various short-term courses are organized frequently. Besides this, the college also conducts certificate & Diploma courses. The college is always on its toes to see that the students are given maximum facilities and quality education. It is because of this policy and sincere efforts; many a student has achieved distinctions in the academic field. The Aim & Spirit of the college, besides imparting quality education, is to cater to the needs of the rural youth in developing their overall personality. The summer camps organized periodically are instrumental in arousing the spirit of nationality & secularism amongst them. The college organizes various cultural, games & sports activities and inspires its students to participate in essay/elocution competitions at Regional, State & National levels. Many students have represented the college in interuniversity/state tournaments and have been awarded for their performance. Our students have brought laurels by fetching prizes, even topping the list, at National Level Essay Competition organized by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Mumbai during the last few years. The college has a spacious Health Centre building equipped with 12 station multi-gym and other fitness gears.



About Dhamangaon Education Society

D.E.S. was fortunate to work under the eminence and proficiency of Late Shri Laxminarayanji Agrawal, the former President and the acknowledged Architect. His unremitting efforts and unrivalled contribution to the worthy cause of education enabled the Society to experience new heights of academic glory. He always believed in and nurtured the philosophy of accepting a child from the swinging cradle and returning it to the society in the form of a cultured youth only after its complete educational metamorphosis. With a view to materialize this concept, the Society has gradually expanded



its hectic academic activities and opened institutions taking care of all stages of education right from pre-primary to post graduation and technical education. Thus, making a modest beginning with a small Middle School in its formative years, the Society over the years has assumed the proportion of a full-fledged educational complex. Presently, the Society through its network of 15 institutions has been making honest efforts to cater to the educational needs of about six thousand students of this region. It needs to be specially mentioned that the Sanskrit Vidyalaya run by the Society is striving for the promotion and teaching of Sanskrit which is believed to be the supreme source of Indian culture.

Having regard to the fact that education plays a key role in bringing up the social structure of the nation, Late Shri Shrinarayanji Agrawal, a yogic man by practice known for his prudence, unparalleled devotion and dedication and above all, his simplicity sowed the seed of Dhamangaon Education Society way back in 1914. He was inspired in this endeavour by his contemporaries, Late Shri Jamnalalji Bajaj and Late Shri Shrikrishnadasji Jaju. D.E.S. thus perhaps happens to be the oldest and pioneering institution in the Vidarbha region rendering yeoman's service to the cause of education in a small town of Dhamangaon and adjoining rural areas of Amravati district.

I am well familiar with the close association of so many years of Respected Shri Alsidasji Rathi alias Babuji with D.E.S., a fatherly figure, apart from being its immediate ex-President and now the senior executive member. He has always been a source of inspiration and guidance for us. His unrivalled contribution in the growth of the Society has experienced new heights. I shall ever hold him in high reverence and shall carry his debt of gratitude joyfully.

After the sad demise of Shri Laxminarayanjii Agrawal on 9th June 1988, Shri Narayandasji Bhattad served the Society as its President from 1988 to 1991. During his Presidency, the Society in 1989 entered 75th year of its fruitful existence and therefore had the distinction to celebrate its Platinum Jubilee.



In November 1991, Shri Alsidasji Rathi, the then Secretary of the Society took over as its President and continued till November 2000. His ability to act decisively and readiness to work efficiently helped the Society to make great strides during his term of Presidency. He was mainly instrumental in providing sound financial base to the Society.

During 2000, the then President, Shri Alsidasji Rathi and the members of the Society unanimously decided with an earnest feeling to entrust its leadership to the youths. Consequent on this decision, Shri Sharadkumar Agrawal, a dynamic personality having intrinsic interest in the field of education along with his young executive associates, having been elected unopposed, assumed the reins of D.E.S. on 17th November 2000. Thus, following in the steps of their elders and cherishing the ethical values accepted by them, the young office bearers are determined to bring about the conspicuous progress of the institutions of the Society.

It is our prime objective to pursue excellence in our work by synergizing the efforts of all of us. There had been plenty of activities and ample to look forward to. I am confident that with the support and active co-operation of all, we shall be able to rise to the occasion to meet the future needs and challenges of the academic circle.

Though the students seeking admissions to the institutions of D.E.S. are mostly from rural background, their performance in various examinations on most of the occasions is encouraging and at times, even exemplary. Eligibility: The Candidate should have passed PG examination in the concerned subject with minimum 55% marks / equivalent grade in the qualifying examination. (For the reserved category candidates, minimum 50% of Marks is required in all the branches) & passed the entrance test (PET) or who have qualified UGC/SET/CSIR (JRF) or possess regular M.Phil. Degree in the relevant subject or teacher fellowship, followed by the interview conducted by the Research Advisory Committee of the College.

Duration of Ph.D. Programme: 3 to 6 years; however, the extension for a period of maximum one year may be granted on the recommendation of the RAC and with the approval of the RRC.

How to apply? Candidates are required to download the online application form (Appendix-5) available at the university website: http://www.sgbau.ac.in/Ordinance-No.1-2016-About-Ph.D.-.pdf and fill it with all the relevant information. Submit the application form to the respective department on or before 1st December of each year. The Candidate shall have to appear for interview before the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) of the college for discussing proposed research project/ topic / area of doctoral degree. RC shall display the list of selected candidates along with the allocated supervisors who shall be acting as internal evaluators for the Ph.D. thesis. The selected candidate shall confirm the admission by paying the prescribed fees and depositing essential documents on or before 31st December of the year.

Rules Regarding Admission & Scholarship: -

 - 6. Official proof of date of birth (unless date of birth is mentioned in T.C.)
 - 7. Caste Certificate and Validity Certificate, if applicable to students belonging to backward class.
 - 8. Photocopy of Aadhar Card

Note: * Once admitted, the student will not be able to get back the original mark sheet of the board / university examination till the university nomination is received under any circumstances. Its truth should be removed. Original T.C. Xerox colour should not be submitted.

College Information & Rules:

- 1. Student board elections in colleges will be held as per the provisions of Maharashtra University Act 2016. A get-together will not be held.
- 2. Fees will have to be paid accordingly if there is any suggestion from the Government / University or Board of Education to charge more or less.
- 3. Those who have passed the examination in places other than Maharashtra State Board of Education and Amravati University should pay the admission fee as per the rules.
- 4. Students eligible for various concessions will have to pay other fees in addition to the fees received by the college under those concessions at the time of admission.
- 5. The first instalment of senior college tuition fee has to be paid at the time of admission. 2nd week Will have to pay by 03/11/2018. Thereafter, a fine of 50 paise per day will be levied.
- 6. University examination fees have to be paid within the stipulated time as per the rules.
- 7. If you want to leave the college after getting admission in the college, the student has to pay the full year fee.
- 8. Deposits other than the recoverable fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 9. For the second copy of the College Transfer Certificate (T.C.) Rs. 50 / will have to be paid. No other copy can be obtained without a strong reason.
- 10. The principal will have the right to withhold the admission card of the student who has any amount of fees or other arrears.

1. College Exam:

Evaluations are conducted by the college in the required sessions / test examinations. Student attendance is mandatory for these examinations.



2. University / Board Examination:

As per the board / university rules, no student can sit for the university examination if his / her attendance in each subject class is not at least 75%. Along with this N. C. C. And 75% attendance in physical training classes is also mandatory to be able to sit for the university examination. At least 75% attendance is also mandatory to be eligible for fee concessions and scholarships.

Physical training classes and physical fitness tests:

As per the rules of the university, all the students in the undergraduate class are given P.O. T. Attendance at class is mandatory. At the end of the year, they will have to take a physical fitness test. Students who do not appear for the PT or do not appear for the Physical Ability Test will not be allowed to sit for the examination unless there is sufficient and acceptable reason. N.C.C. The taking student must also take a physical ability test. Students who fail this exam will be penalized.

Health check: As per the rules, all the students will be examined once a year. Students absent from this test will be penalized.


