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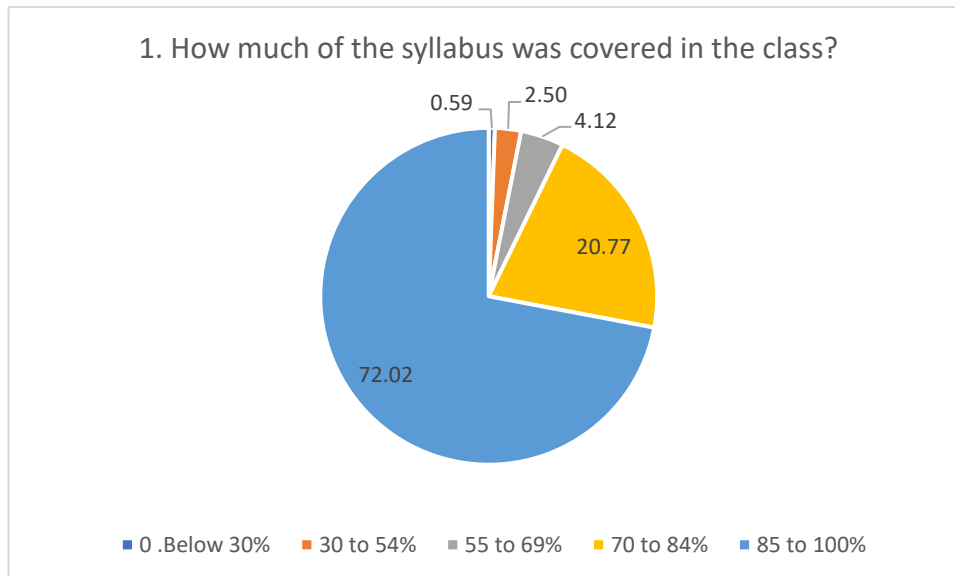

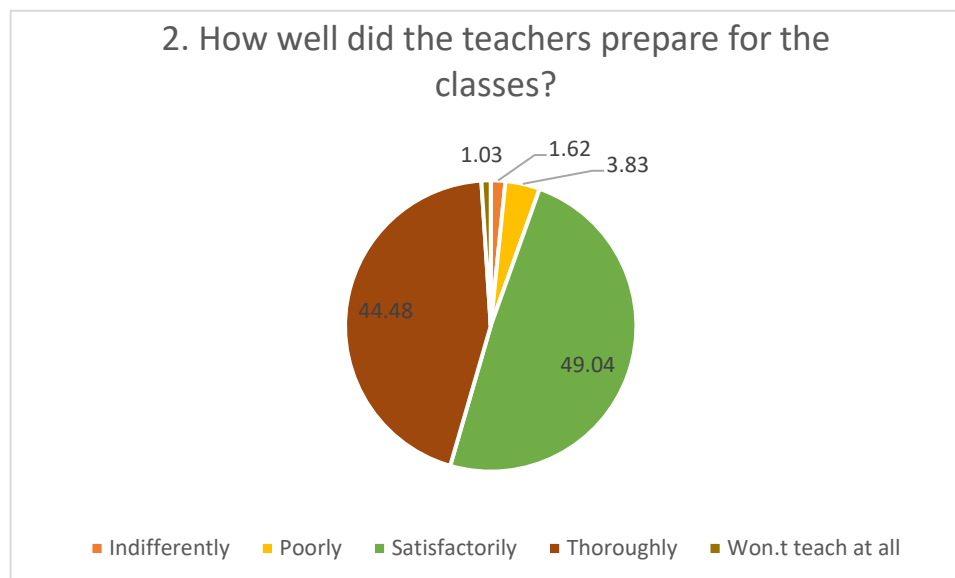
REPORT ON STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2021-2022

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



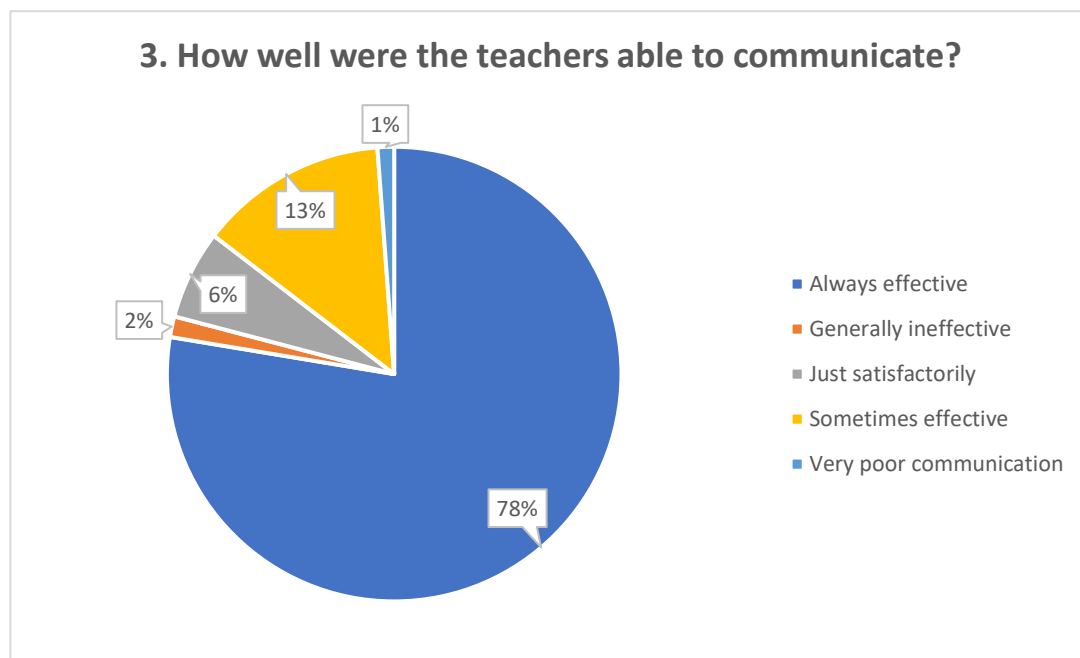

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



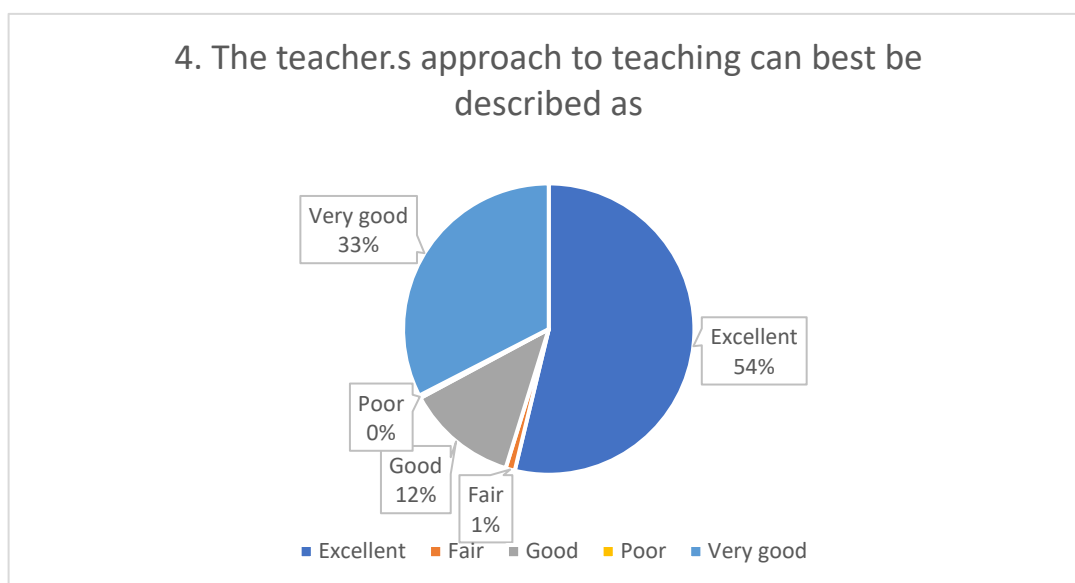

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



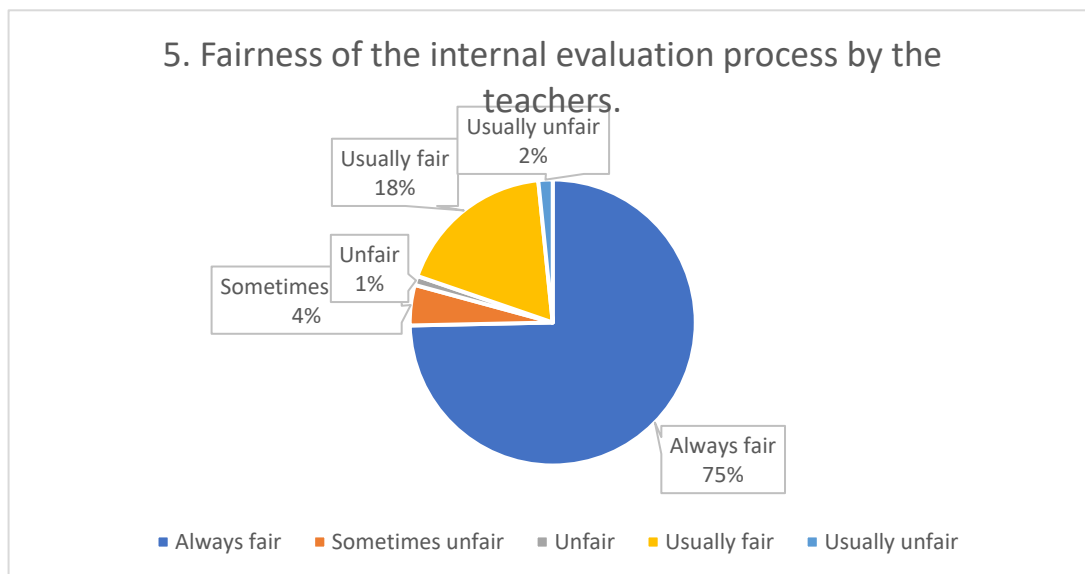

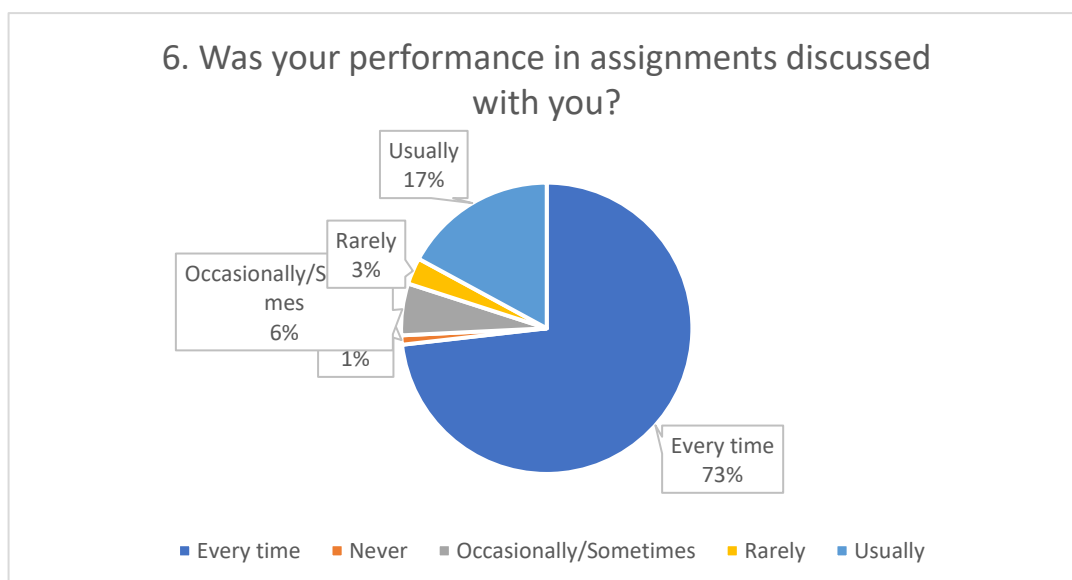

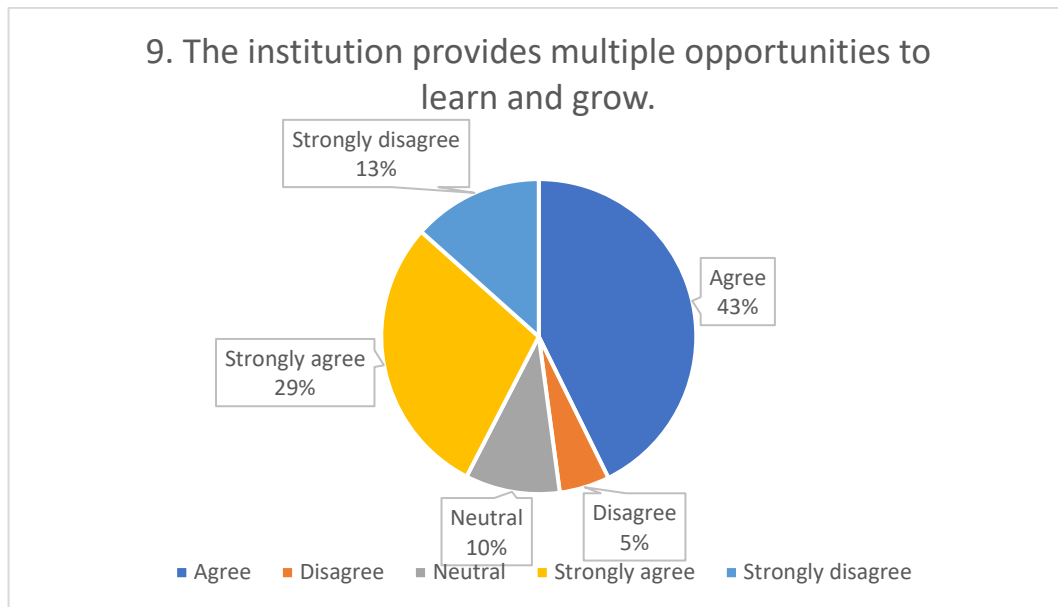

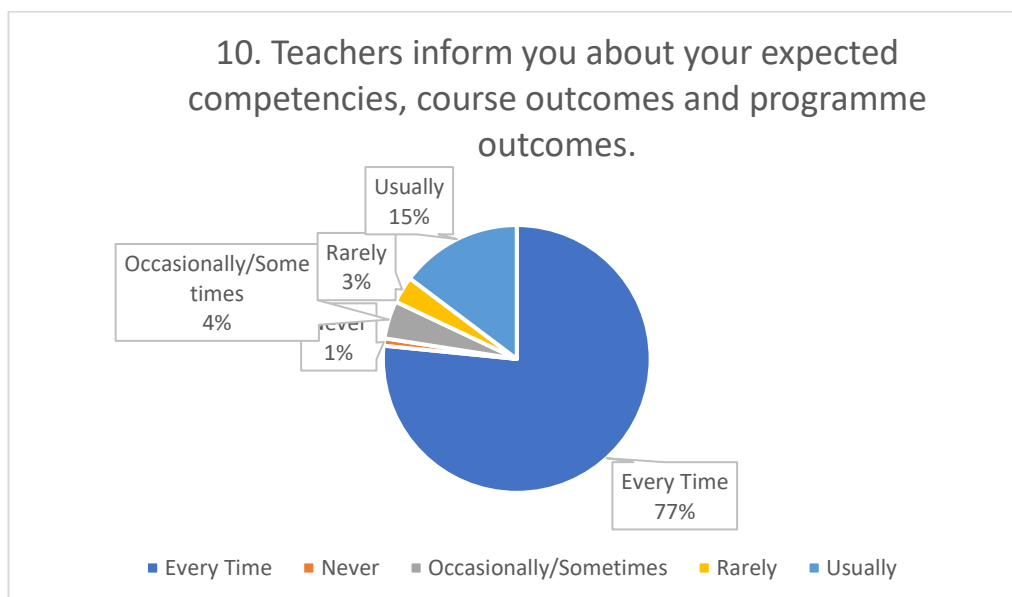

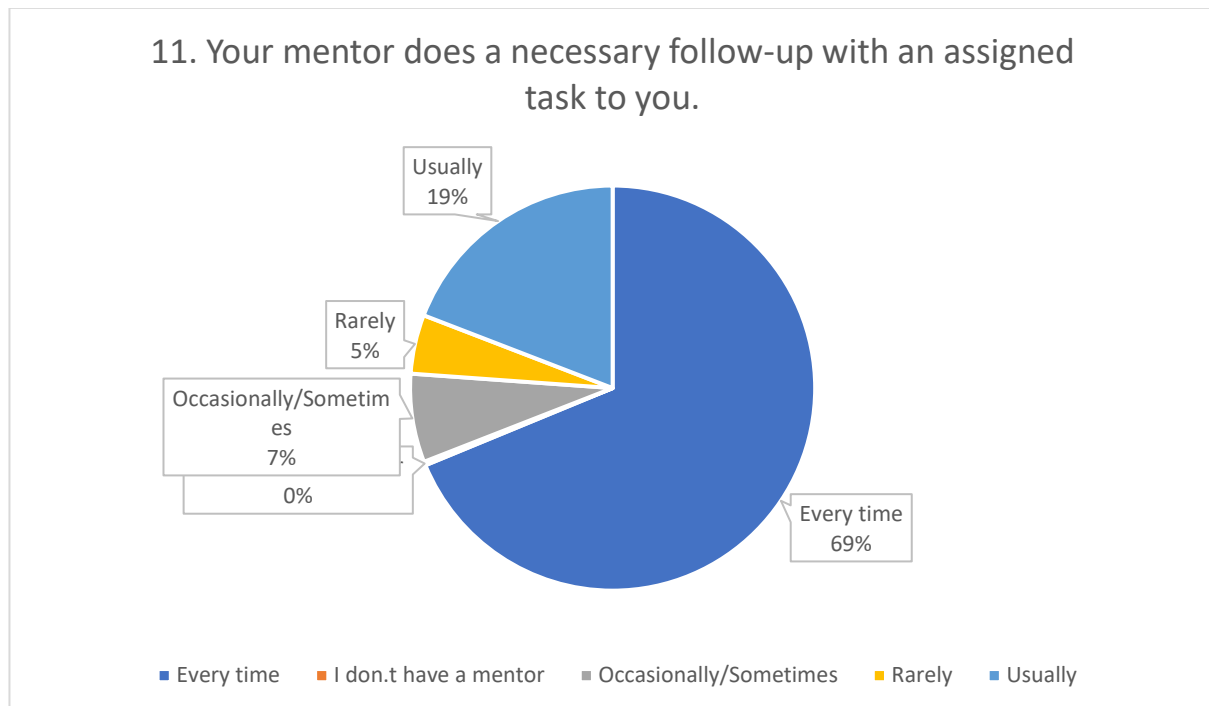

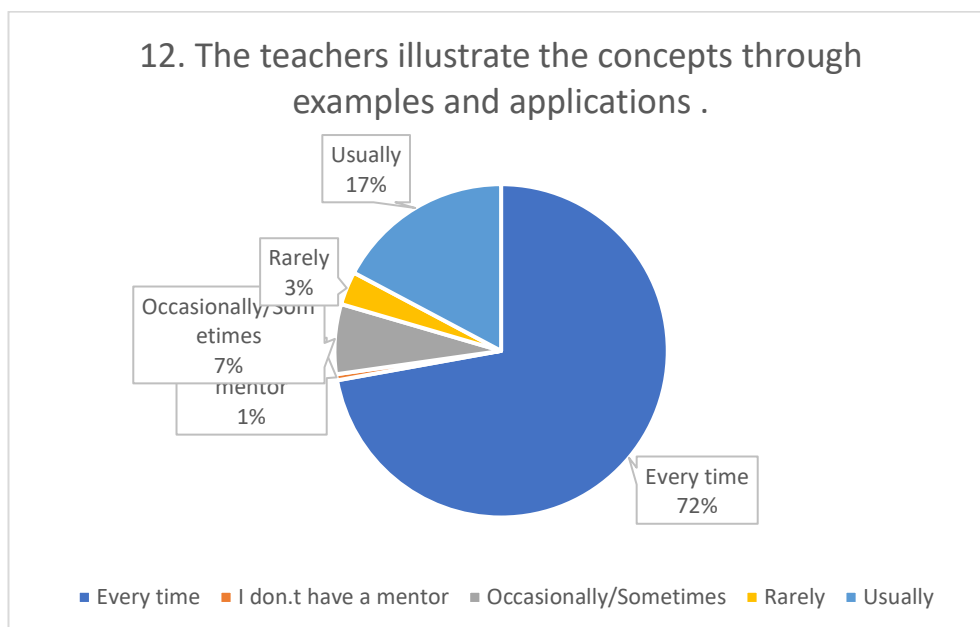

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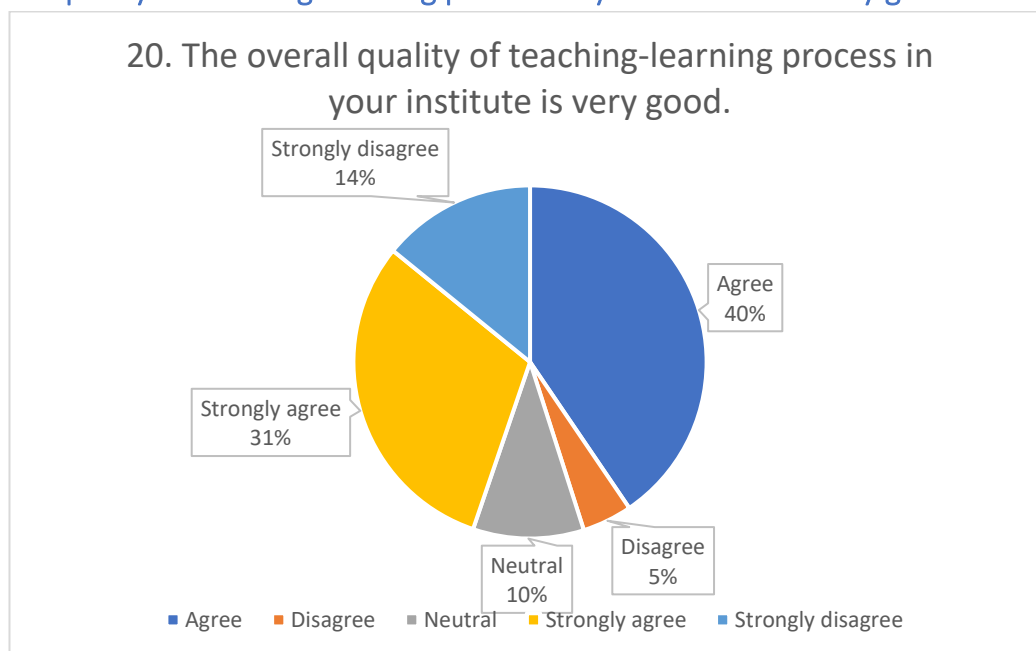
